This seminar will cover why charities have long term investment portfolios; look at how they are structured; and discuss the current market environment and the implications for charity portfolios and income flows



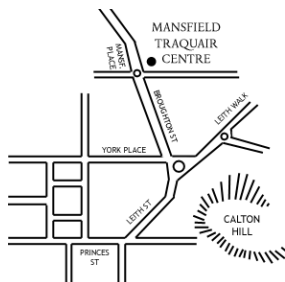
